The following is a Pre-Detection checklist list prior to the arrival of the K9 Bed Bug Detection Team. Please be advised that upon arrival, this checklist will be reviewed again.

## **Please Note:**

The K9 Bed Bug Detection Team will not be able to inspect any areas that have been chemically treated by a Pest Control Company within 30 days. If the areas were heat treated the K9 Bed Bug Detection Team will be able to inspect that area within 24 hours.

- 1. It is **IMPERATIVE** that all animals be removed from the property one hour before our arrival.
- 2. An hour before your appointment, set the air conditioner down to at least 70 degrees or below in the summer, or set the heater at 70 degrees or below in the winter.
- 3. The canine handler will first assess the area to be searched.
- 4. Any pets and litter boxes will need to be removed to an area not involved in the search.
- 5. Pet toys, pet food, water, food items, prescription and non prescription medications need to be non-accessible to the K9 Bed Bug Detector.
- 6. Remove all linens from beds. It is best if you are able to move your bed/beds 3 feet away from the wall for a proper Detection.
- 7. Noise and human distraction must be minimized to create the most effective search environment for the K9 Bed Bug Detector.
- 8. Extinguish all smoking materials within the home 2 hours prior to Detection, including any odor products such as plugins or air fresheners of any kind.
- 9. Under these conditions the K9 Bed Bug Detector will perform to its highest accuracy rate.

In order for the K9 Bed Bug Detector to focus on his job, we ask that any socializing with the K9 Bed Bug Detector must wait until after the search is complete.
